

IMPORTANT MESSAGE FROM THE BOARD EFFECTIVE MARCH 1, 2018

At our February meeting, we made a decision to eliminate the free entrance for birthdays. If it is your birthday month you are currently getting into the last dance of the month for free, with the exception of November and December which is the first dance of the month. Some people cannot make the dance in the month that their birthday falls and lose out on getting in free for their birthday.

We have decided to do something different, which will give every member an opportunity to come to one dance a year for free. Here is how things will work starting in March.

Every member will be entitled to 1 free dance a year. You get to pick the dance that you would like to come to for free, with a few exceptions listed in the next paragraph. When you get to the door you will tell the people behind the desk that you would like to use your free dance. They will ask you for your membership card and they will punch it and return it to you. That's it!

Now, here is the IMPORTANT part, the dance must be at the legion hall (no Chevy Chase or other outside dances). Dances where food is served, such as St. Pat's Party, Baseball night, Tailgate party and Holiday Party or if we have another night with food you WILL NOT be able to use your free dance. Dances where we serve just coffee and cookies or cake are fine.

You MUST have your membership card with you on that night; there are no excuses or exceptions.

For those of you with January or February birthdays, if you came to the January or February dance and came in as a birthday you will not be able to come in again for free until next year. If you did not come to that dance then you will be entitled to your 1 free dance of your choosing.

Remember, YOU MUST HAVE YOUR MEMBERSHIP CARD on the night you chose to come in for free – NO EXCEPTIONS will be made.

For those of you that send birthday wishes, we will still continue to print the birthdays in the newsletter.

Every so often we receive suggestions from our members; we discuss every one of them and decide whether or not it would be good for our club. This one came to us from Ralph Dahma – great idea.
